Saint Joseph Cemetery would like to thank everyone for choosing us as your families resting place. The employees and Board of Directors of Saint Joseph Cemetery work hard trying to keep up with the maintenance along with any and all other issues that arise from time to time. With the cost of upkeep and maintenance needed our main goal is to keep Saint Joseph Cemetery financially solvent and to maintain the beautiful cemetery we strive to provide to all our families. As some of our local cemeteries are having financial issues our main goal is to not have to worry about jeopardizing our perpetual care account for years to come. With a little help from our parishioners, we can all make this happen. In your May envelope packet you will find a Special Envelope with Saint Joseph Cemetery's name on it. We are hopeful that our Parishioners will consider making a donation to the cemetery to help us secure our financial goals for future years.

Below is some of our overhead cost our cemetery occurs throughout the year:

- Utilities \$4200.00 Operations \$9400.00 Sewage \$750.00
- Phone \$1200.00 Fuel for Mowers \$5500.00 Insurance \$18400.00
- Repairs and Maintenance \$5800.00

Our Oil Wells throughout the cemetery help us some but have recently come down tremendously with the low price of oil.

If you haven't purchased your memorial graves and /or your Memorial Stones please contact our superintendent Shawn Young as he will assist everyone to find their perfect resting place, in our Cemetery, whether it's on the grounds for a traditional burial or in our beautiful Mausoleum of Ascension for both cremation and traditional burials. Our current prices for cemetery ground graves is \$550 for one and families can save \$50 off on the second grave. Our current fee for a traditional burial open and close is \$750 and \$350 for cremation burials. We offer our 15x15 tent rental for all ground services for an extra fee of \$125.00. We also charge an additional \$300 for any burial services after 3pm Monday thru Friday and any burial on Saturdays. If you wish to be interred in our Mausoleum of Ascension, included in that purchase includes the use of the Mausoleum for cemetery services, includes the open and close, you can save the extra money from having to purchase a headstone/monument, and the need for a concrete vault. The after 3pm and Saturday fee still applies even for the Mausoleum purchase.

Saint Joseph Cemetery also offers all your Memorials needs whether it is a single/double flat grass marker, to slant markers, or monuments we can help you. **All profits from your memorial purchase stay here at your local cemetery**, plus Saint Joseph Cemetery waives the fee for the foundation which is less money our parishioners have to spend for their memorial. Our Memorials are the exact same memorial that you can purchase from other memorial dealers, you just save extra money while your purchase helps your local cemetery. Starting prices for some of our quality Memorials are:

- Single granite grass markers \$750 (free foundation)
- Double granite grass markers \$1500 (free foundation)
- Granite slant marker \$900 (free foundation)
- Granite Monuments \$1800 and up (free foundation)
- Granite benches \$1100 (free foundation)
- Park style granite benches \$1800 (free foundation)
