Five steps to Safer Environments—The Diocese of Erie mandates that all people who work with children and youth in our parishes and schools undergo child abuse prevention training. The training details five steps to prevent child sexual abuse.

1. Know the warning signs!
2. Control access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children and youth.
3. Monitor all programs for the safety of children & youth.
4. Be aware of and sensitive to what is going on in their lives.
5. Communicate concerns to the appropriate person in authority.
