

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

As I am writing this column today (Tuesday) we are awaiting the publication of the grand jury report concerning child sex abuse by clergy in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There has been much published about the 900+ page report. Bishops in the six dioceses that are covered in the report have already received an advance copy of the unredacted report. Individuals named in the report have received a copy of the section of the report in which they are named.

As we know some of the individuals named have objected to the Supreme Court for a number of different, but valid reasons. Those objections have delayed the publication of the report as the Court tries to work through the objections.

Regardless of all that, the fact that there needs to be an investigation at all is a great tragedy. In a perfect world the church would be a source of light without any darkness. Obviously, that is not the case. All levels within the church have experienced the darkness.

To all the victims of clergy sex abuse, I am profoundly sorry and I pray for your healing. I pray that the darkness has not overcome the light for you. I pray that the ineptitude with which the church has dealt with the scandal has not soured you to the possibility of good in the church. I pray that each of you find vessels of God's grace in your lives bringing consolation and healing.

I pray for the church that with God's grace we will be able to root out this darkness, no matter how long it may take or how painful it may become.

To have to write a column like this where darkness comes from every level, from Cardinals, to bishops, to priests, to deacons, to religious and to laity is gut-wrenching. We are all in need of God's mercy. *Father Rick*
