I have been playing phone tag with Fr. Mike Polinek for the past few weeks concerning a date for a school mass and for organizing a St. Andrew Dinner. A St. Andrew Dinner is a vocation awareness initiative sponsored by Fr. Mike as the Vocation Director of the Erie Diocese. The idea is to offer young men the opportunity to have a good meal, the chance to talk to several priests and the Bishop about the vocation to the priesthood, and the time to see that each young man is not alone in attempting to discern God's call.

The St. Andrew Dinner is open to gentlemen of just about all ages and from all locations. We would open our doors to welcome people from our area, not just St. Joes and St. Luke's. In fact, the truth is the more attending the better. We would be doing this in conjunction with Fr. Jim and Holy Redeemer/St. Anthony's. So why undertake this initiative. Certainly, the decline in the number of priestly vocations in our Diocese and Pastoral Plan give us

the push to do something. Warren has had a rich history of producing vocations to the priesthood, but the number has declined drastically over the past 20 years. There are many good and holy families, faithful in the practice of their faith in our area. But the media climate of our time makes choosing the vocation of priesthood difficult.

Deacon Ian and I had several good discussions about the differences between the 70's when I went through the seminary and today as he is making his way through the seminary. One common need for both times is the necessary support from family and parish. Maybe by hosting a St. Andrew Dinner we can show our support to any young man who is thinking about being a priest.
