Angel Tags

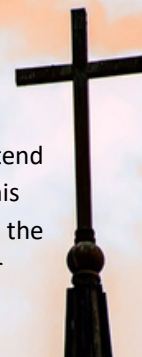

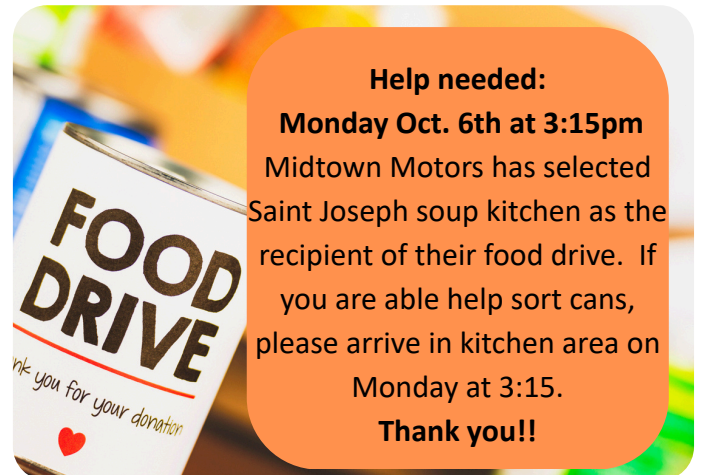
